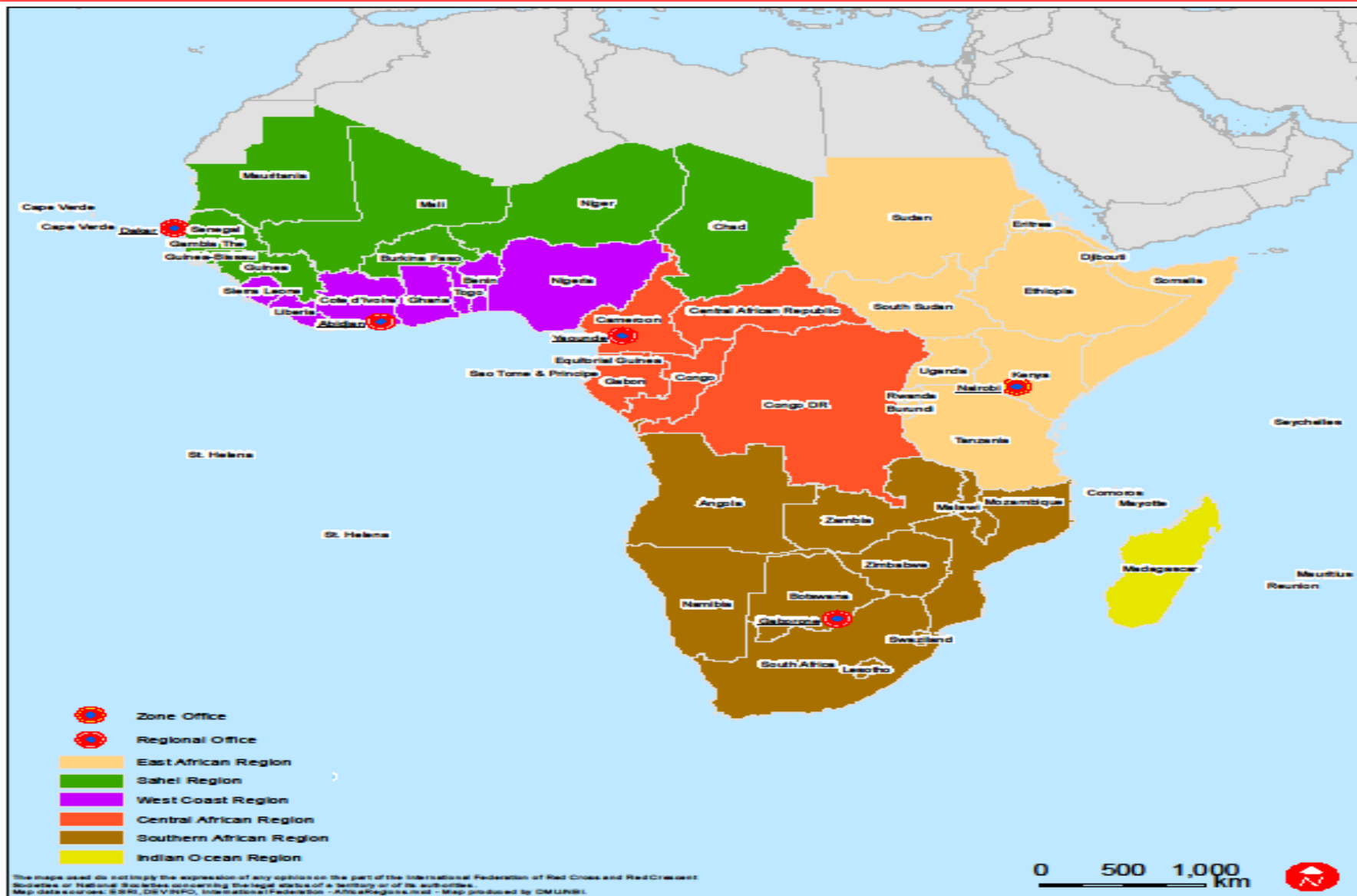

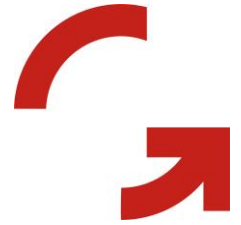

Africa Zone and Regions

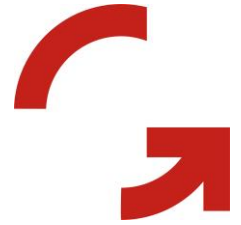


IFRC Current Africa Operations 2016



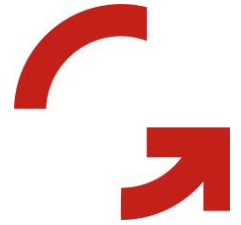
- **Ebola Operations** are not over working on recovery plans
- **Regional FS Crisis** in Southern Africa (Lesotho/Malawi)
- **Nigeria crisis** is affecting Nigeria, Cameroon, Niger and Chad
- **Regional FS Crisis** affecting the **Sahel**
- **CAR and South Sudan** crisis still ongoing with regional impact
- **Population Movement** – Tanzania / Burundi
- **Cyclical flooding** – Malawi / Mozambique / Zimbabwe

Africa Region Challenges



- Large number of operations v capacity
- Funding sources reducing – more actors
- Corruption and Integrity
- Access to funding for slow on set disasters
- NFI v Cash / Local Procurement
- High inland transport costs
- Lengthy clearance / customs / cross border
- Certification – SGS / KEBS
- Tax free status
- Partner capacities
- Logistics Cluster only in South Sudan / DRC

IFRC Africa Region – Best Practice



- Regional Sourcing
- Market assessments
- Stock prepositioning strategy
- Surge capacity / Peer to Peer Support
- Talent support and training - IFRC / NS / RDRT
- Increased coordination with ICRC and logistics actors
- Information sharing – supplier performance
- Increased sharing of lessons learnt from other regions
